## Role purpose

- You are involved in drawing up the bid phase, order acceptance/launch, design and the production phase of a project and products. You supply input to different teams to enable the set-up of the supply chain for the entire Life Cycle of the products, including Life Cycle Costs and service provision.
- You will contribute to the implementation of the necessary processes within Production, Quality and Customer Service, with training and information sessions for our own teams and the teams of our partners.
- You continuously guide our production partners to further expand & optimize the production process by adapting the tools, quality, components, production procedures, etc.
- You are looking for solutions for possible repairs or blockages in the production process, during assembly or during the test phase.
- You know our test benches & can support our partners with troubleshooting in case of problems during testing.
- You will take up during start-up the daily planning with our partner & follow up the local stock with them.
- You communicate with your colleagues from Product Management, Quality, Development & Production to formulate objectives and understand requirements.
